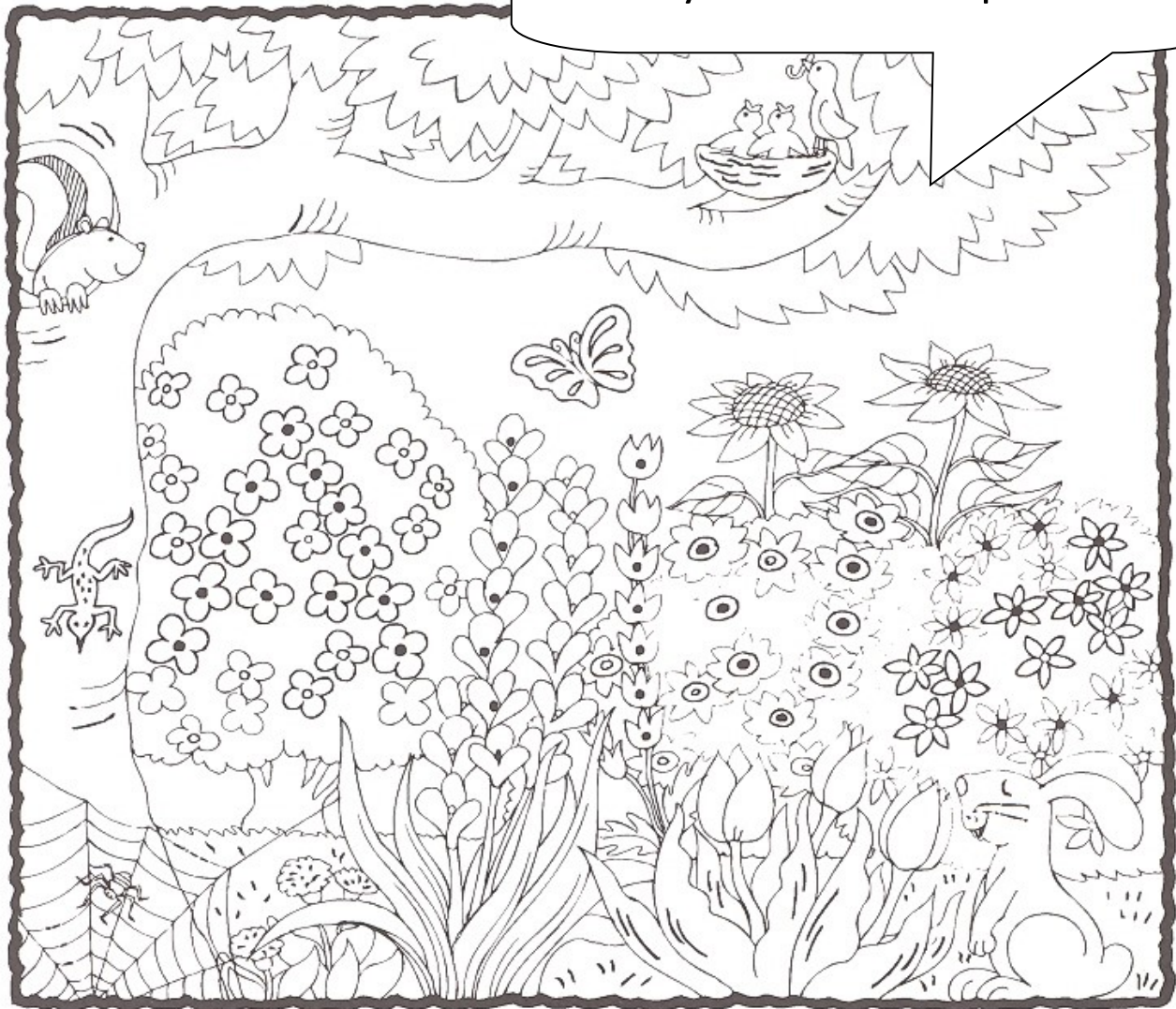
Jesus is always ready to listen to children

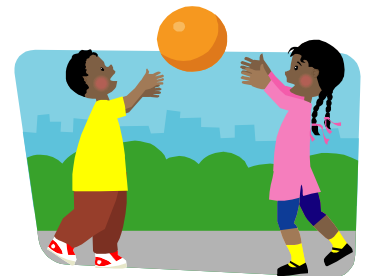
Jesus, friend of little children,
