

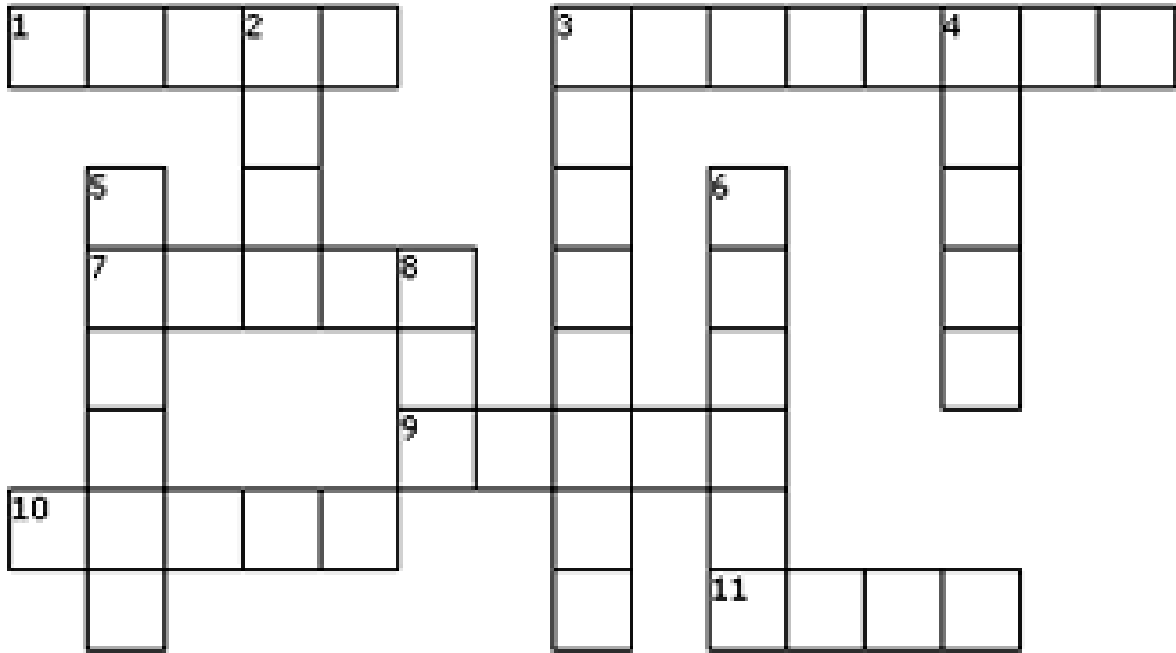

My first is in **glad** and **happy** and **praise**

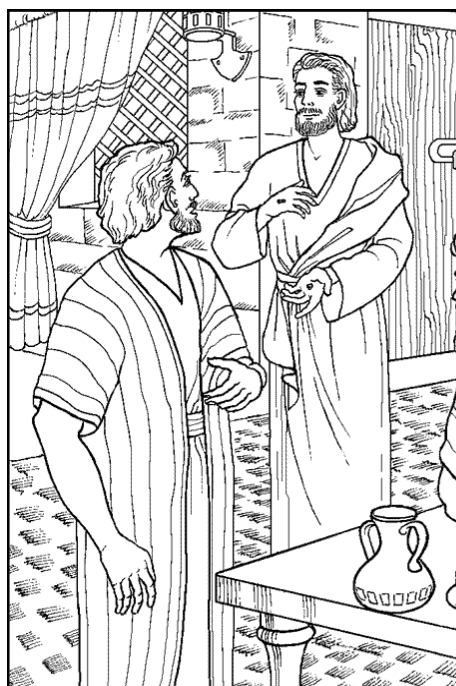
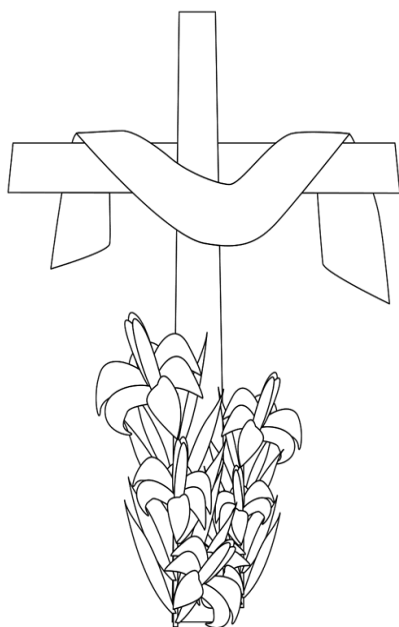
My second's in **light** and **candle** and **blaze**
