Is it someone from the old days? Like you see in church windows. And they've got rings round their heads?

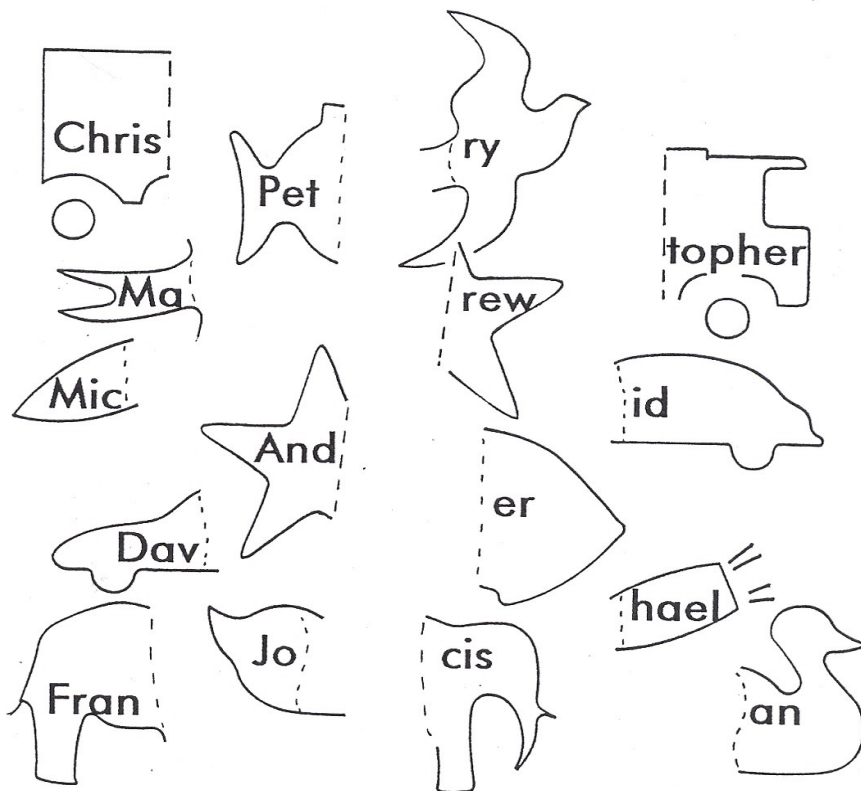
Some of the Saints did live a long, long time ago; but some are much more recent, and some are alive and working for God today.

My Church is dedicated to a Saint, and I know a lot about him. Is yours? And do you?

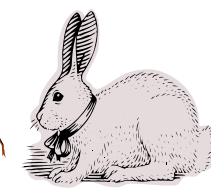
Jesus went to the village called Bethany, where a woman called Mary ran to meet him

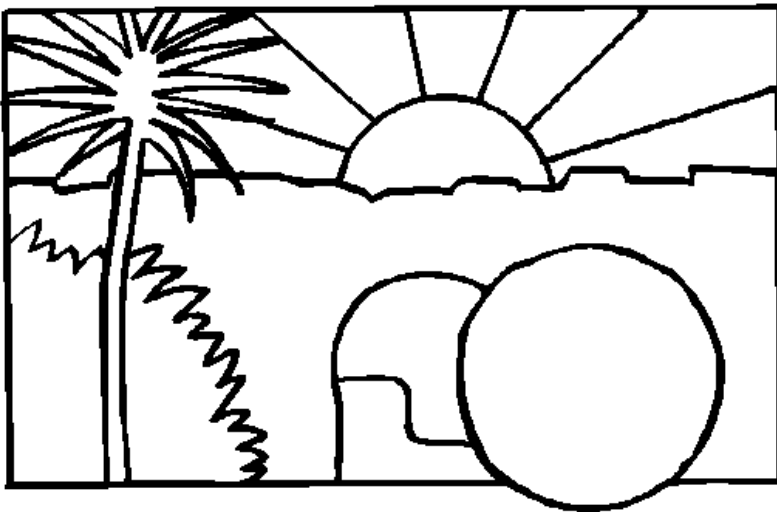
