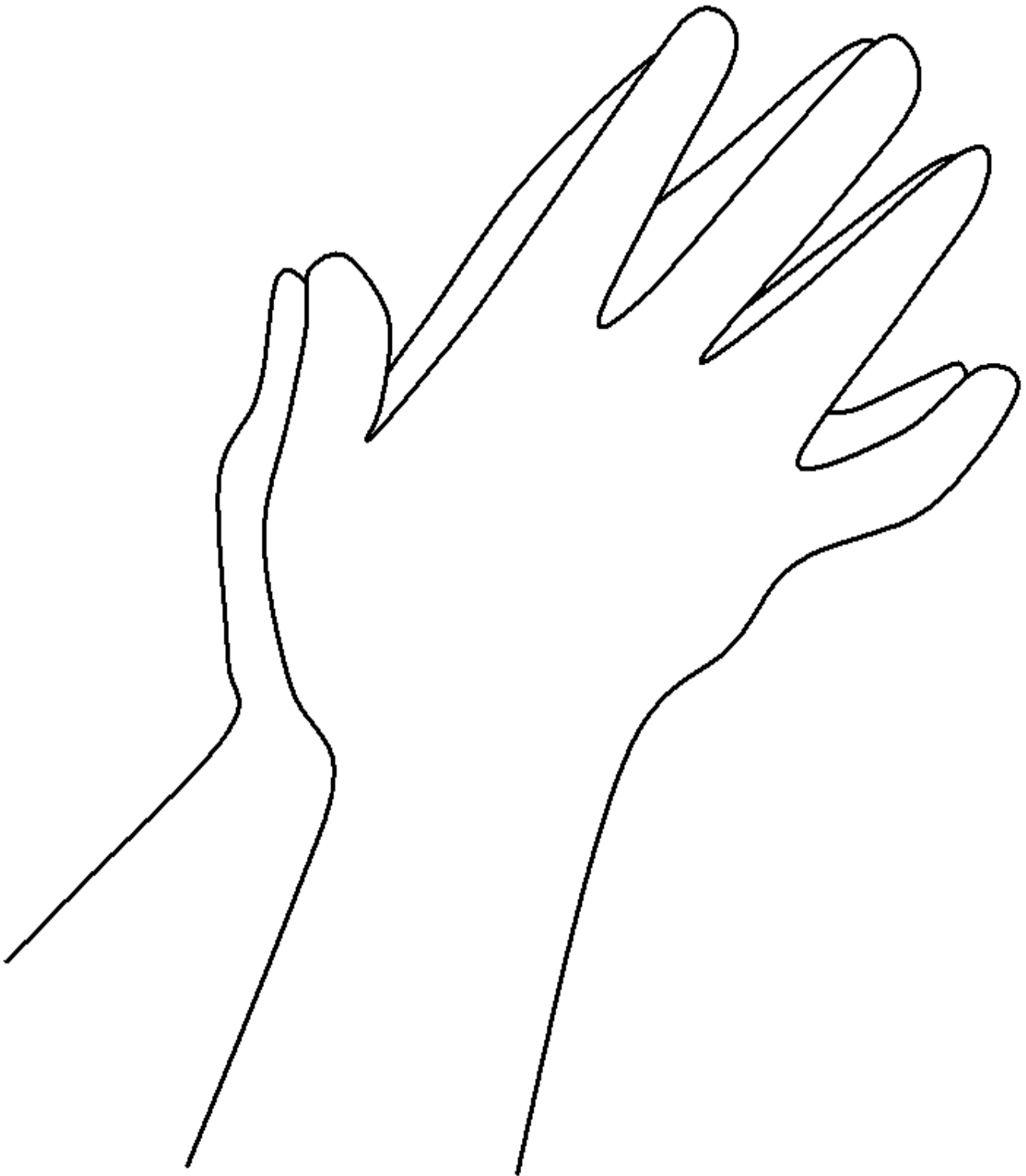


Young Church Mag
